- 20 Points for news media coverage of Snowmobiling (News paper, TV, Radio, Need proof)
- 20 Points for participating in an emergency plan for public service (Police, fire, and EMS, Hospital & Rest homes, & others)
 (Type of proof, pictures, letter of participation from organization)
- 20 Points for having Snowmobile safety class (when listed on DNR website)
- 15 Points for club participating in awards for Snowmobile Dealer of the Year
- 15 Points for club participating in awards for Snowmobiler of the Year
- 15 Points for club participating in awards for Snowmobile Family of the Year
- 15 Points for club participation in awards for Groomer Operator of the Year
- 15 Points for filling out Charity Report
- 15 Points for club raising money for any community Charities (Excluding Club Challenge and Spina Bifida)
- 15 Points for club donating to Club Challenge
- 15 Points for club donating to Spina Bifida
- 15 Points for Hosting ISSA Campout
- 1 Point per member, for raising club memberships from prior year (Per ISSA Records)
- 10 Point for club attending convention, campout (each event) (Excluding board Officer, director, assistant, committee members & past Presidents)
- 10 Points for club participating in Scrapbook contest at convention
- 10 Points for club having booth at convention
- 5 Points for EACH newsletter in the IOWA SNOWMOBILER
- 5 Points for club member present at EACH Association Board Meeting (excluding board Officer, director, assistant, committee members & past Presidents)
