The elections that will occur this November 2004 may very well be the most important National election in recent history. There have been continuing attacks against snowmobiling by National elected officials. Legislation was introduced into the House of Representatives that would have banned snowmobiling in Yellowstone National Park if passed. We understand subsequent legislation is being considered by the enemies of snowmobiling and outdoor recreation in general and we must respond to these challenges.

The Friends of Snowmobiling Political Action Committee (FOSPAC) has been established as a voluntary non-profit, unincorporated Political Association. The purpose of FOSPAC is to provide a means for individuals to give financial support, on a voluntary basis, to political candidates and committees at the Federal Level. The committee will support individuals seeking election or re-election at the National level who understand the concerns and the important issues of the snowmobiling community throughout the United States. The goals of this committee are to encourage and support better government by supporting candidates for Federal Office that support issues related to responsible snowmobiling.

The Friends of Snowmobiling Political Action Committee had remarkable success in its first election year of 2002. For the 2002 elections, it was the goal of FOSPAC to support friends of snowmobiling. Hundreds of donations were sent to FOSPAC from snowmobilers across the country with one objective in mind: to support individuals at the Federal Level who are friends of snowmobiling.

We are happy to report that of all the candidates receiving financial support from FOSPAC for the 2002 elections, 94% were victorious (16 out of the 17 candidates supported with FOSPAC contributions.) It was a great accomplishment. Now more than ever, friends of snowmobiling must unite and through FOSPAC support candidates that openly support snowmobiling as a great winter recreation activity.

Members of the snowmobile community have a long history of involving themselves in public policy decisions. This Federal Action Committee is an important tool for the community to actively support candidates that understand and support snowmobile issues.
