

RULES FOR TRAIL USERS

Snowmobiles must yield to all other vehicle traffic at all times. If you encounter horse drawn vehicles, please limit your speed to avoid spooking them. We rely on landowners for our trails; please respect them at all times.

These trails are funded by your registration dollars and the Snowdrifters Inc. No tax dollars are used to create or maintain these trails for Snowmobiles. The money received from the sale of these maps and the donations is used by the Snowdrifters Inc. to maintain these trails for your safety and enjoyment.

STAY ON THE MARKED TRAIL. If you put a single track in the wrong place, others may follow it. This can cause the loss of trail sections. The most common complaint are for noise and riding off the trail. Please ride quietly around housing areas and in towns. We sometimes face opposition when

trying to expand the trail system, or maintaining what we have, because of noise.

Know the rules for the towns you ride through. Some of them are posted on this map. Repeated violations will jeopardize the trails.

Always check the condition of ice yourself before traveling across it.

Please limit trail usage during marginal snow conditions.

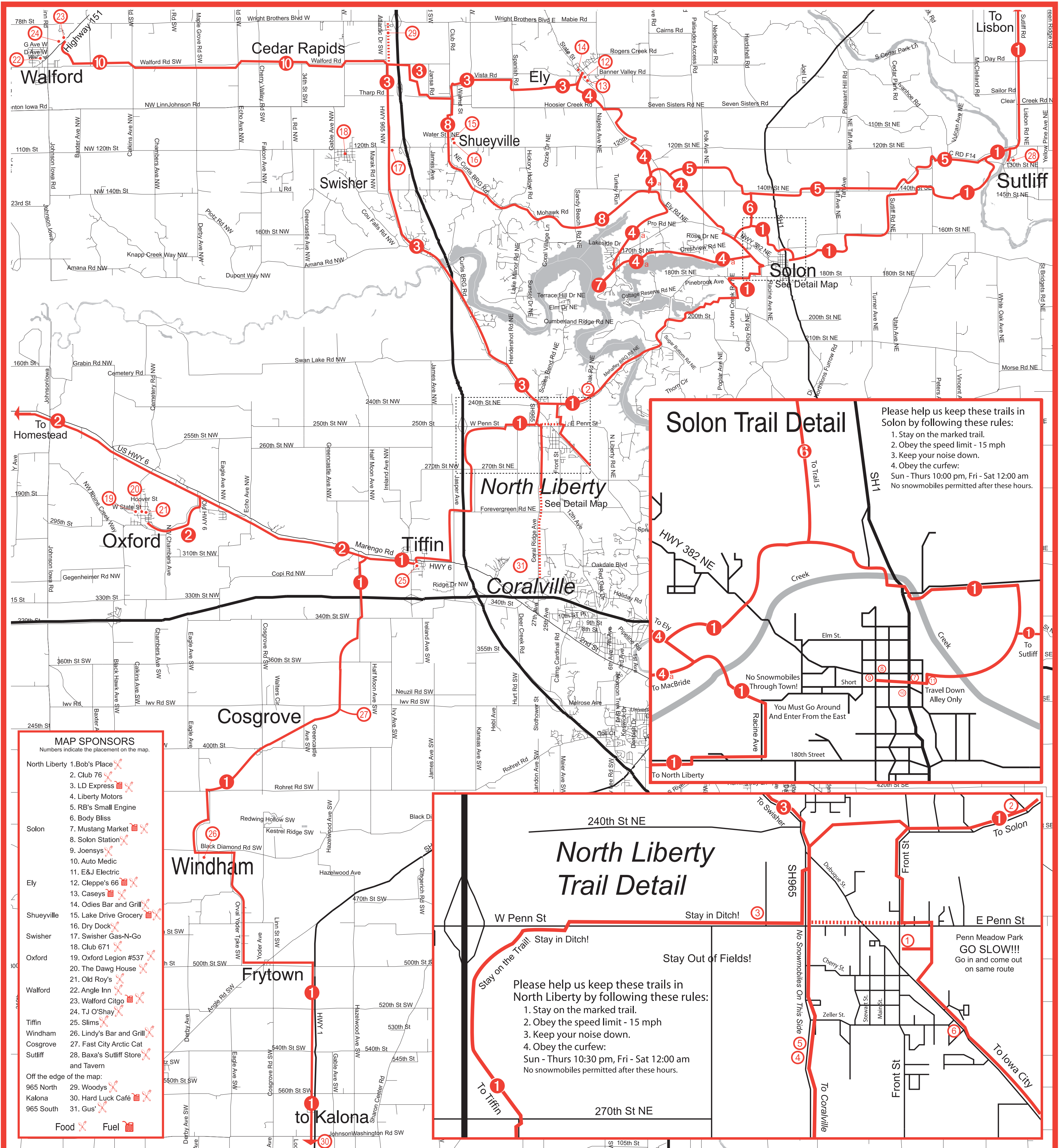
