



Clarification on the Program

- FRT funds we receive from the lowa DOT can only be used for be used to fund equipment purchases and major projects
- Registration and Out of State Trail Pass dollars will pay for the operational expenses of the program & administration costs

Clarification on the Program

- The FRT funds no longer have the Buy America requirement for projects under 500K
- We are still restricted on what we can buy. Only New equipment or Parts.
- We have worked with Iowa DOT to set up Sole Source information to help speed up the purchase process. But it still takes time.
- The Registration and Trail Pass dollars do have specific guidelines for the way they can be used

Record Keeping and Reimbursement

Club Reimbursement

- Clubs will be paid \$11.00 per mile groomed based on the data gathered by the SNARS program.
- Miles reported out of the set Trail Map (repair facilities or fuel) will not be covered right away. These miles will be considered for coverage at the end of the season based on available funds.
- Clubs will be responsible for all fuel and general maintenance cost for the groomer granted to them.
- Any Repairs that the club wants full or partial reimbursement MUST be requested on SNARS and approved before repairs are started.
- All Maintenance and Repairs MUST be reported on the new log program.
- All revenue the club receives from grooming stays with the club

Record Keeping and Reimbursement

1STGP covers all major repairs
100% on program owned groomers
50% on co-op and club owned machines.

- These repairs are handled with a MAJOR REPAIR request on SNARS
- Full or Partial reimbursement MUST be requested on SNARS and approved before repairs are started.
- Please include explanations, estimates, and other supporting documents.
